Instructions: Upon successful completion of the *Motor Vehicle Record (MVR) Review* and *USA Water Ski & Wake Sports Online Trained Boat Driver Course (or written test at an in-person Trained Driver Clinic)*, an aspiring trained boat driver must satisfactorily complete the on-water practical evaluation administered by a USA Water Ski & Wake Sports-rated Trained Boat Driver or sport discipline-rated driver. Refer to the <u>USA Water Ski & Wake Sports Trained Boat Driver Program Description</u> for more information.

The student must operate the towboat while towing a skier and demonstrate proficiency in the areas listed below. The session will begin with the boat docked and the engine off. The Test Administrator will ride in the boat as the student completes all of the necessary steps to take the skier on a safe ride and return him and the boat safely to the starting area. All students must tow at least one skier; however, it is preferable that all students pull two skiers.
